‘theCITY’ features State of the City speech

City Manager Daniel Valenzuela’s State of the City address, delivered at a San Angelo Chamber of Commerce luncheon on Aug. 12, is the focus of the newest episode of “theCITY.”

The airing of the speech temporarily displaces the City of San Angelo-produced show’s usual interview format in an effort to make the speech more readily available to anyone wishing to view it. The State of the City address will air daily at 10 a.m., 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. from Friday, Aug. 15, through Aug. 29 on SATV, the City’s government access channel on Suddenlink cable Channel 17. Additionally, local FOX affiliate KIDY will air the episode at 9 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 17, and Sunday, Aug. 24. KIDY is channel 10 on the Suddenlink system.

The State of the City address has traditionally been delivered during the Chamber’s monthly luncheon in August. This year’s speech, delivered at the West Texas Training Center, recounts many of the accomplishments of San Angelo’s municipal government over the past year and focuses on the opportunities and challenges of the coming year, including water issues and street maintenance.
