CITY OF SAN ANGELO

1888-1891:

Historical records show City of San Angelo was first incorporated by an election on January 15, 1889, 245 for and 242 against. July 11, 1893, the corporation was dissolved by a vote of 284/266. February 26, 1903, vote to incorporate was 205/171. Boundaries set out and COSA incorporated under the General Laws on March 3, 1903.
